FIREWORKS

Act 74 of 2022

What are the restrictions on their use?

- Cannot be ignited or discharged on public or private property without express permission of the property owner
- Cannot be directed at another person
- Cannot be discharged from or directed at a building or vehicle
- **Cannot be discharged within 150 feet of a building or vehicle regardless if the building or vehicle is owned by the user of the consumer fireworks**
- Cannot be discharged while the person is under the influence of alcohol, a controlled substance or another drug
- Municipalities may restrict use of consumer fireworks between 10 p.m. and 10 a.m. except: July 2, 3, 4 and Dec. 31 when they may be used until 1 a.m. If July 4 falls on a Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday they may be used until 1 a.m. on the immediately preceding and following Friday and Saturday
- The following may take, remove or cause to be removed all stocks of consumer or display fireworks sold, used, stored, or held in violation of this law: PSP, Act 120 certified municipal police officers, a sheriff or sheriff's deputy, A member of a Pennsylvania bomb squad accredited by the FBI and certified in hazardous devices training
- Check with your local municipality for applicable local ordinances.

BOROUGH ORDINANCES TO KEEP IN MIND

Chapter 113: Grass and Weeds

No grass or weeds can exceed a height of 5". Residents are responsible for weeds growing on the sidewalks from the curb to their residence.

Chapter 163: Rental Occupancy Reports
